Protecting Your Health and Safety at Work

- Understand and follow the contents of the Workplace Safety and Health Program including all policies, guidelines and safe work procedures.
- Maintain and wear all personal protective equipment required to perform a task safely.
- Use all equipment in a safe manner as required by the manufacturer, policy or safe work procedure.
- Participate in all applicable safety training and education programs.
- Report Work Related Injuries, Illnesses and Near Misses
- Know the hazards and report any unsafe conditions or acts in a timely manner. Bring forward ideas for safety improvements to your supervisor and/or Workplace Safety and Health Committee.
- Know where emergency equipment is located and follow all emergency procedures (codes).
- Know your Rights and Responsibilities: The Right to Know, The Right to Participate, The Right to Refuse, The Right to Protection from Reprisal.
